1	UKZN Law Clinic Durban	<p>The current projects undertaken at the clinic are:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A joint pupil enrichment programme with the Luthuli Museum involving pupils from high schools in the KwaDukuza (Stanger) district focusing particularly on legal knowledge and skills. 2. Training of law students to deliver rights awareness workshops in the surrounding local communities. This is a joint venture with other NGO's, namely CAST and Urban Aid. The actual workshops began in about August 2014. <p>The above projects were done in association with Street Law at UKZN.</p>

3	Nelson Mandela Metropolitan University Law Clinic	<p>All law students had to hand in a Portfolio of Evidence as part of the Legal Practice-course. The results were excellent and the students view their work from a much more serious perspective. They must reflect on all their experiences and challenges at the end of every session at the Law Clinic, which (written) reflection must be included in their Portfolios of Evidence.</p>
