ID	Law Clinic	Main challenges in terms of legal aid provision
1	UKZN Law Clinic Durban	The ratio of supervisor to student capacity is very limited.
		In estates involving property transfers, there is not much that the clinic can do except to advise the client.
		Both the Director and the Principal Attorney are full-time academic members of staff who divide their time between the Clinic's responsibilities and lecture loads
2	Univen Law Clinic	Finance, infrastructure and lack of staff.
3	Nelson Mandela Metropolitan University Law Clinic	No Labour Law-experts. Not enough manpower. Adequate funding for subsidising expenses (eg sheriff's fees in certain cases)
4	North West University Community Law Centre	Shortage of staff.
5	Rhodes University Law Clinic	n/a
6	UCT Law Clinic	No funding for indigent peoples' matters. Sheriff accounts and Windeed – constant administrative problems related to payment with the result that they sometimes refused to serve unless paid. Payment done via financial office.
7	University of Johannesburg Law Clinic	We do not have a budget to assist clients with disbursements. Any case requiring experts cannot be done properly as the clients do not have money to pay experts. There are too few attorneys appointed to deal effectively with the number of students and do their own court appearances. We do not have a messenger.
9	North West University Law Clinic	Legal costs (Sheriff's fees, etc.)
10	University of Pretoria Law Clinic	The University itself primarily support cases where teaching or research is involved. Totally reliant on outside funding for other cases.
11	UWC Legal Aid Clinic	Funding, Resources and Capacity. There is not enough skilled staff to do human rights related litigation. We still operate like a general practice. Quantity rather than quality due to funder demands.
12	Wits Law Clinic	Funding in terms of completion ie. Atlantic Philanthropy Funding. Increase in student numbers. Increase in faculty requirements.
13	Legal Aid Clinic - Stellenbosch University	Finding financial support for salaries
15	University of Fort Hare Law Clinic	The clinic has recently become operational and as such has many teething issues like accessing funds and budgetary cuts.
