Eddie Hanekom is the Director of the University of Pretoria's Law Clinic. He holds the degrees B Juris (UNW) LLB LLM (cum laude) (UP). He is also the lecturer in the final year LLB module Applied Legal Studies at the University of Johannesburg. After doing his articles in 1988 to 1989, and being admitted as an attorney in 1991, he was employed at the Multilateral Motor Vehicle Accident Fund, before entering private practice. He was an academic associate and lectured in the Law of Criminal Procedure at the University of Pretoria before he joined the University of Johannesburg in 2007. He practices as an Attorney of the High Court of South Africa. He previously specialised in Road Accident Fund claims, other personal injury claims, criminal cases and matrimonial law. He was working in Clinical Legal Education at the University of Johannesburg for more than a decade before being appointed as the Director of the University of Pretoria Law Clinic. He is the current President of the South African Universities Law Clinics Association (SAULCA). Since 1999 he has been an instructor and later senior instructor for the Law Society of South Africa (LSSA) Legal Education and Development (LEAD) at a number of Schools for Practical Legal Training, training candidate-attorneys in the topics of personal injury claims, legal costs, matrimonial law and numeracy. He also been the chair of the LSSA LEAD's Review Panel for the Personal Injury Claims Manual during 2016.
